



NUISANCE PREVENTION

SURVEILLANCE

Video and live surveillance will be available to ensure that the establishment does not create nuisance conditions in the parking area, sidewalk, street, and area surrounding the premises and adjacent properties. Loitering will not be allowed or tolerated. Waiting queues will be housed inside the facility to mitigate loitering outside the building.

All litter and waste will be properly disposed of to minimize the development of odor and the potential for attracting pests.

An industry-standard air filtration system will be used to eliminate any possible odors from the facility.

LIGHT POLLUTION

Rolling Hills will mitigate the potential for light pollution through appropriate fixtures that do not illuminate beyond the property line. Further, Rolling Hills will not install any neon or illuminated signage.

Rolling Hills does not anticipate any noise pollution from mechanical equipment. We will not use radios or loudspeaker equipment for the advertising of marijuana.

PARKING

Rolling Hills has sought out insight from local departments regarding parking requirements and will continue to work with the community on the plans to prevent customer parking impacting the neighborhood.

TRAFFIC

Rolling Hills will remain vigilant to the imprint of traffic and address our procedures to prevent standing traffic around the building or in the neighborhood streets.

PUBLIC SAFETY

Rolling Hills commits to implementing the highest standards of procedures for safety and security, meeting all required state and local level.

SECURITY MEASURES

935 CMR 500:110 sets forth the following security requirements that we have taken into consideration when constructing our facility design:

- On-site security staff -- during all hours of operation.
- No marijuana signage or products will be visible from outside the facility
- Our parking lot will be well-lit and monitored using an outdoor camera feed to ensure no loiterers
- Camera feeds maintain 90 days of footage
- Required I.D.s at our entrance to prevent unauthorized entrance into areas containing marijuana
- Secured, smart-access storage facilities
- We have a "panic button" that immediately notifies local law enforcement of an emergency
- We will regularly consult with the Town's Police Department to promote public safety and preventing the diversion of products to minors.

Rolling Hills will contract with a professional security and alarm company to design, implement, and monitor a comprehensive security plan to ensure that the facility is a safe and secure environment for employees, customers, and the local community.

WE HAVE A ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY AGAINST INDIVIDUALS UNDER 21 YEARS OF AGE OBTAINING CANNABIS.

To ensure there will not be a diversion to minors, on our premises, we maintain live outdoor camera feeds and have a 3 step verification process before selling customers any products.

There will be zero public access to the retail.

3 STEP VERIFICATION

ENTRANCE All store visitors will be required to present their I.D. before entering our secured merchandise floor.



VERIFICATION

Each customer I.D. is verified and added to their customer profile.



POINT OF SALE ID

Our budtenders are required to ask for I.D. before finalizing a purchase.
